GUIDELINES FOR THE AUTHORS

Dear Friends...

Analytical Geography is a bi-annual Journal of the Association for Geographical Studies, Delhi, published in the months of June and December. It accepts only original research papers and articles, which have not been published in any journal, book, internet etc. in language from scholars of geography and allied disciplines. The paper must be in English and its length may be around 6000 words inclusive of figures/ tables/ photographs. Paper should have an abstract (not exceeding 250 words) placed at the head of the text with 6 keywords. The manuscript should be organized in following manner. The first page should indicate title of the manuscript, name of the authors and complete address of their institutions, mailing address including email address. If there are 2 or more authors for a manuscript, the corresponding author should be clearly mentioned; else correspondence will be done with the first author unless otherwise requested. References cited in the text should be alphabetically arranged at the end of the paper. It should be as under-

For paper in the book- Mishra, S. (2011) Political Geography, Delhi: University Press.

For paper in the edited book- Davis, J. S. (2009) "Concept and theories in regional planning", in R.N. Singh (eds) Readings in Regional Science, New Delhi: Indian Publisher, 67-89.

For paper in the journal- Dev, M.N. (1995) "Place and crimes: A study for crime prevention", *Analytical Geography*, 2: 34-45.

Tables and Figures should be numbered (e.g. Table 1 or Figure 1) in ascending numerical order. However, they must be quoted at appropriate places in the text. Tabulated data should not duplicate those shown graphically. Paper should have a final section headed 'conclusions', which summarizes important conclusions emerging from the work. Manuscript typed in the Times New Roman double spaced with font size of 12 pt in A4 size in MS-Word. It may be sent by email (bwpdsegeo@gmail.com or agsdelhiuniversity@gmail.com) to the editor along with a hardcopy to the Editor. Dr. B.W.
